PRIVACY POLICY

i. Introduction

The Affective Brain Lab from the Brain and Cognitive Neuroscience Department at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology (M.I.T.) ("us", "we", or "our") operates Digital Diet mobile app and its web browser extension for the Chrome web browser (hereinafter referred to as "Service").

This Privacy Policy governs your use of the mobile app and the web browser extension for the Chrome web browser Digital Diet, and explains how we collect, safeguard and disclose information that results from your use of our Service.

We use your data to provide and improve Service. Collected, aggregated, and anonymized data are also used for research purposes. By using Service, you agree to the collection and use of information in accordance with this policy.

ii. Definitions

SERVICE means the Digital Diet mobile app the browser extension for the Chrome web browser Digital Diet.

PERSONAL DATA means data about a living individual who can be identified from those data (or from those and other information either in our possession or likely to come into our possession).

USAGE DATA is data collected automatically either generated by the use of Service or from Service infrastructure itself (for example, the duration of a page visit).

COOKIES are small data files stored on your device (computer or mobile device).

DATA CONTROLLER means a natural or legal person who (either alone or jointly or in common with other persons) determines the purposes for which and the manner in which any personal data are, or are to be, processed. For the purpose of this Privacy Policy, we are a Data Controller of your data.

DATA PROCESSORS (OR SERVICE PROVIDERS) means any natural or legal person who processes the data on behalf of the Data Controller. We may use the services of various Service Providers in order to process your data more effectively.

DATA SUBJECT is any living individual who is the subject of Personal Data.

THE USER is the individual using our Service. The User corresponds to the Data Subject, who is the subject of Personal Data.

iii. Information Collection and Use

We collect different types of information for various purposes to provide and improve our Service to you.

iv. Types of Data Collected

Personal Data

While using our Service, we may ask you to provide us with certain personally identifiable information that can be used to contact or identify you ("**Personal Data**"). Personally identifiable information may include, but is not limited to:

O Username (e.g., your email address)

- o First name and last name
- Cookies and Usage Data

We may use your Personal Data to contact you with newsletters, research or promotional materials and other information that may be of interest to you. You may opt out of receiving any, or all, of these communications by emailing us.

Mobile App Privacy Note

The mobile apps distributed via the Apple App Store and Google Play Store do not collect or store any personal user data. While the apps retrieve content analysis scores (such as emotion, knowledge, and actionability) from a secure cloud database based on data generated through your use of the Digital Diet Chrome Extension, no information about your identity, search history, browsing activity, or device usage is collected or transmitted. Your use of the mobile apps remains entirely private.

Usage Data

We may also collect information that your browser sends whenever you visit our Service or when you access Service by or through a mobile device ("Usage Data").

This Usage Data may include information such as your computer's Internet Protocol address (e.g. IP address), browser type, browser version, the pages of our Service that you visit, the time and date of your visit, the time spent on those pages, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data. This Usage Data may also include your search queries and other information related to your web browsing activity.

When you access Service with a mobile device, this Usage Data may include information such as the type of mobile device you use, your mobile device unique ID, the IP address of your mobile device, your mobile operating system, the type of mobile Internet browser you use, unique device identifiers and other diagnostic data.

When you use access Service with the browser extension, this Usage Data may include information such as your web browsing history, including the domain names or URLs you visited, time of the visit, and any clicks on search results.

Also, to improve Service and for research purposes, we may collect your responses to questionaries and surveys that were displayed to you in the mobile app or via the web browser extension.

Tracking Cookies Data

We use cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on our Service and we hold certain information.

Cookies are files with a small amount of data which may include an anonymous unique identifier. Cookies are sent to your browser from a website and stored on your device. Other tracking technologies may also used such as beacons, tags and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze our Service.

You can instruct your browser to refuse all cookies or to indicate when a cookie is being sent. However, if you do not accept cookies, you may not be able to use some features of our Service.

Examples of Cookies we may use:

- o Session Cookies: We use Session Cookies to operate our Service.
- Preference Cookies: We use Preference Cookies to remember your preferences and various settings.
- o **Security Cookies:** We use Security Cookies for security purposes.

v. Use of Data

We use the collected data for various purposes:

- o to provide and maintain our Service;
- o to notify you about changes to our Service;
- o to allow you to participate in interactive features of our Service when you choose to do so;
- o to provide support;
- o to gather analysis or valuable information so that we can improve our Service;
- o to monitor the usage of our Service;
- o to detect, prevent and address technical issues;
- o to fulfill any other purpose for which you provide it;
- o in any other way we may describe when you provide the information;
- o for research and Service evaluation purposes;
- o for any other purpose with your consent.

vi. Retention of Data

We will retain your Personal Data only for as long as is necessary for the purposes set out in this Privacy Policy. We will retain and use your Personal Data to the extent necessary to comply with our legal obligations (for example, if we are required to retain your data to comply with applicable laws), resolve disputes, and enforce our legal agreements and policies.

We will also retain Usage Data for internal analysis and research purposes. Usage Data is generally retained for a shorter period, except when this data is used to strengthen the security or to improve the functionality of our Service, or we are legally obligated to retain this data for longer time periods. All Usage Data intended for research purposes will be aggregated and anonymized, and we will take all the steps reasonably necessary to ensure that you cannot be identified based on your Usage Data.

vii. Limited Use Disclosure

The use of information received from Google APIs will adhere to the Chrome Web Store User Data Policy, including the Limited Use requirements.

viii. Transfer of Data

Your information, including Personal Data, may be transferred to – and maintained on – computers located outside of your state, province, country or other governmental jurisdiction where the data protection laws may differ from those of your jurisdiction.

Your consent to this Privacy Policy followed by your submission of such information represents your agreement to that transfer.

We will take all the steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this Privacy Policy and no transfer of your Personal Data will take place to an organisation or a country unless there are adequate controls in place including the security of your data and other personal information.

ix. Disclosure of Data

We may disclose personal information that we collect, or you provide:

O **Disclosure for Law Enforcement.** Under certain circumstances, we may be required to disclose your Personal Data if required to do so by law or in response to valid requests by public authorities.

Other cases. We may disclose your information also:

to our subsidiaries and affiliates;

to contractors, service providers, and other third parties we use to support our Service;

to fulfill the purpose for which you provide it;

for any other purpose disclosed by us when you provide the information;

with your consent in any other cases;

if we believe disclosure is necessary or appropriate to protect the rights, property, or safety of the Data Controller, our partners, or others.

x. Security of Data

The security of your data is important to us but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet or method of electronic storage is 100% secure. While we strive to use acceptable means to protect your Personal Data, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

xi. Your Data Protection Rights Under General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR)

If you are a resident of the European Union (EU) and European Economic Area (EEA), you have certain data protection rights, covered by GDPR. – See more at https://eur-lex.europa.eu/eli/reg/2016/679/oj

We aim to take reasonable steps to allow you to correct, amend, delete, or limit the use of your Personal Data.

If you wish to be informed what Personal Data we hold about you and if you want it to be removed from our systems, please email us.

In certain circumstances, you have the following data protection rights:

- o the right to access, update or to delete the information we have on you;
- o the right of rectification. You have the right to have your information rectified if that information is inaccurate or incomplete;
- o the right to object. You have the right to object to our processing of your Personal Data;
- o the right of restriction. You have the right to request that we restrict the processing of your personal information;
- the right to data portability. You have the right to be provided with a copy of your Personal Data in a structured, machine-readable and commonly used format;
- o the right to withdraw consent. You also have the right to withdraw your consent at any time where we rely on your consent to process your personal information;

Please note that we may ask you to verify your identity before responding to such requests. Please note, we may not able to provide Service without some necessary data.

You have the right to complain to a Data Protection Authority about our collection and use of your Personal Data. For more information, please contact your local data protection authority in the European Economic Area (EEA).

xii. Your Data Protection Rights under the California Privacy Protection Act (CalOPPA)
